RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current NEHC rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
- 2. The Committee reserves the right to vary or change show officials or judges. To decline any entry and cancel, divide or combine classes if there are less than four entries.
- 3. Any horse entered and not exhibited shall forfeit fees, unless the committee is presented with a veterinary certificate or in equitation only, a physician's certificate in the case of the rider. There will be a charge of \$25.00 per entry.
- 4. The committee reserves the right not to delay classes due to conflicts and not allow substitutions of classes or horses.
- 5. No exhibitor or person shall approach a judge as to a decision or other matters unless they first obtain permission from the Show Steward. Any exhibitor or person disregarding this rule may be asked to cancel all entries and forfeit entry fees. Judges' decisions are final.
- 6. Please remember to bring your pony and junior hunter measurement cards and amateur certification. Numbers will not be issued without them.
- 7. ENTRIES may be faxed to 508-530-3263 until 5:00pm the Friday before the show. After 5:00pm entries will be considered Post Entries. Post entries will be accepted the day of the show, however, there will be a onetime post entry fee of \$25.00. No penalty fee will be charged for entering additional classes on the day of the show.
- 8. Prize money will be deducted from your horse show bill at the Secretary's office.
- 9. Schooling will be permitted in authorized areas only. Anyone found violating these rules shall forfeit all entry fees and not be allowed to show.
- 10. Course will be posted at the gate all day.
- 11. A trophy and six ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise specified.
- 12. All horses entered in stake or championship classes must show in one other class in the same division.
- 13. All dogs must be leashed at all times.
- 14. The championship and reserve shall be awarded to two of the four horses that have acquired the most points performing over fences in conformation and working classes; only those horses shall receive points for ribbons won in under saddle classes. Champion and reserve in all performance divisions. Points: 10-6-4-2-1-1/2.
- 15. All juniors in hunter, jumper, and hunter seat equitation sections cannot ride anywhere on the show grounds without wearing protective headgear passing testing standards. Harnesses must be secured and if said headgear has a brim, it must be flexible or semi-flexible. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until his headgear is properly in place.
- 16. Checks returned for any reason will be subject to a \$50.00 fine.
- 17. Entries not paid the day of the show will be subject to a \$100.00 fine.
- 18. Open check written to SEHA must be left with Entry Blank in order to pick up exhibitor number.



CLASS AND DIVISION DESCRIPTIONS – Three Rings

Elementary Hunter/Equitation (Unrated)

Open to green horses (in hunter section only) and/or novice riders eligible for Walk Trot and Short Stirrup. To show at a walk and trot only on the Flat. Fences no higher than 18'. Classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6

Short Stirrup Hunter (NEHC Rated "C" & MHC Rated "C")

Open to Riders 12 years of age and under. To show over a course of 4 to 8 fences at a height of 18". Under Saddle class will show at a walk, trot and canter. Rider may not show in any class requiring fences higher than 18". Only 8 horses or ponies to canter at once. Classes 7, 8, 9

Short Stirrup Equitation (NEHC Rated "C" & MHC Rated "C")

Open to Riders 12 years of age and under. To show over a course of 4 to 8 fences at a height of 18". On the Flat class will show at a walk, trot and canter. Rider may not show in any class requiring fences higher than 18". Only 8 horses or ponies to canter at once. Classes 10, 11, 13

MHJ Short Stirrup Medal

Open to Riders 12 years of age and under. To show over a course of 4 to 8 fences at a height of 18". The fences shall be cross rails or verticals with no combinations. To fill a class and for points to count at least two riders must complete the course. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 11. After August 11 only those riders not qualified may continue to compete in the class. Class 12

Lead Line (MHC Rated "C")

Open to Riders 6 years of age and under. To show collectively at the walk and individually at the trot. To be judged with emphasis on equitation; also suitability and manners of mount to be considered. Leader on foot must be 14 years of age or older. Rider may only compete in this division. Classes 26, 27, 28

Long Stirrup Hunter/Equitation

Open to riders 13 years of age and over. To show over a course of 4 to 8 fences at a height of 18". On the Flat classes will show at a walk, trot and canter. Rider may not show in any class requiring fences higher than 18'. Classes 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19

Walk Trot (NEHC Rated "C" & MHC Rated "C")

Open to Horses and Ponies. Open to Riders 10 years of age and under who have not shown in any class that requires a canter. Rider must show in regular class in order to compete in the championship class. Classes 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25

Hunter Pleasure (NEHC Rated "C" & MHC Rated "C")

Open to all Horses of the Hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitation to the status of the Rider. To show at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the Horses' mouth is required. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness. Rider must show in Class 29 to show in Class 30



NEHC Pleasure Class (NEHC Rated "C")

Open to all Horses and Ponies to be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Will be required to back. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality, in that order. Loose rein on command of judge only, but without loss of contact. Class 31.

MHC Adult Medal

All Riders must present a valid membership number before entering this class. Open to adult members of MHC. Course requires 8 Fences 2'6" to 2'9" with at least one change of direction. Once qualified, rider is no longer eligible for this class. One or more individual tests of the top 4 competitors may be requested at the judge's discretion (USAE tests 1-17). To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course. Class 48

MHJ/SEHA Adult Medal

Open to Amateur Adult riders. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 Fences 2'9" to 3' including a combination with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. To fill, at least 2 competitors must complete the course. Class 49

NEHC Amateur Adult Medal

All Riders must present a valid membership number before entering this class. Open to adult members of NEHC. Course requires 8 Fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top 4 competitors may be requested at the judge's discretion (USAF tests 1-19). To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course. Class 50

Amateur Adult Equitation (NEHC & MHC Rated "C")

Open to Amateur Adult Riders. Fences 3'. Classes 47, 51, 69

Open Equitation Division (NEHC & MHC Rated "C")

Open to Junior riders. Fences 3'. Classes 53, 56, 57

MHC Junior Hunt Seat Medal

All Riders must present a valid membership number before entering this class. Open to junior members who have not reached their 18th birthday. Course requires 8 Fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual test of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USAE test 1-19). Any qualifying Rider is not eligible to enter at future shows. 10 points are needed to qualify for Finals. To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course. Class 58.

MARSHALL & STERLING CHILDREN'S HUNTER CLASSIC

Open to junior riders. Only M&S members will receive points. To be eligible for points, a horse/pony must complete the course in at least two classes over fences in the Children's Hunter section at the same show. The top 12 horses/ponies from the first round will return to jump a second round in reverse order of their scores in the first round; lowest score going first and highest score going last. In case of ties, order of those tied to be drawn. Scores will be averaged from both rounds to determine winners. In case of tie for first place only, the tied horses/ponies will jump a third round over a shortened course to break the tie. The second class of each section of Children's Hunter will count as the rider's first round of the M&S Children's Hunter Classic. The third class will count as the rider's second round. Riders must enter the M&S Hunter Classic prior to competing in the first Children's Hunter class. Each rider that chooses to have the classes count as a M&S Children's Hunter Classic will pay an additional \$30 per class. Classics will not count toward a show champion or circuit champion award. Bit O' Straw Hunter Classic:

A 2'6" classic for the novice-type children's and adult rider. Held as a separate, two-round classic. (i.e., the first round is not be a designated class of a division. Horses will qualify based on points earned in their division during the qualifying period. A horse's points will be recorded only if the rider of record is a current League Member.

MHJ/ SEHA JUNIOR MEDAL.

Open to junior members who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current year. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'3" in height. One or more tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion.(USEF Tests 1-19). Ten points or the finals. To fill a class at least 2 exhibitors must complete the course. Class 59

NEHC Junior Hunt Seat Medal

All Riders must present a valid membership number before entering this class. Open to Riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. Any qualifying Rider is not eligible to enter at future shows violation will forfeit eligibility for finals for that year. Course requires 8 Fences not to exceed 3'3". One or more individual test of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USAE test 1-19). To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course. Class 60

Children's Hunter Horse (NEHC & MHC Rated "C")

Open to Junior Riders. Junior riders 15 to 17 years of age, must be eligible for Intermediate Equitation over Fences as of December 1st of the current show year. Fences 3" - spreads not to exceed fence height. Same Horse/Pony-Rider combination may not show in any other rated division except Equitation at the show. Horses may be shown by another Rider in any other division. To show at a walk, trot and canter. Classes 52, 54, 55.

Low Hunter (Unrated)

Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on age or status of rider. Fences 2'. Classes 32, 36, 37

Pre-Children's Equitation

Open to Junior riders who are eligible for Limit equitation over fences as of December of the current show year. Horses and ponies. Fence height 2' with no combinations. At the same show, the same horse/rider or pony/riders may not cross enter into the Children's Equitation classes, or any equitation class where the fences exceed 2'3". Classes 33, 38, 39

Children's / Adult Special Hunter (MHC Rated "C")

Open to Amateur Adult and Junior Riders. No Professionals. Open to Horses and Ponies that have not jumped 3' or over in the previous year, OR Riders who have not shown at 3' or over in the previous year. Fences not to exceed 2'6". No in and outs. Classes 34, 40, 41

Children's Equitation (NEHC & MHC Rated "C")

Open to Riders who are eligible for Children's Hunter who have not shown over a course where the fences exceed 3' at a recognized show. Fences 2' for small and medium Ponies, 2'6" for large Ponies and Horses. Classes 35, 42, 43



MHC Mini Medal

All Riders must present a valid membership number before entering this class. Open to Riders who have not reached their 15th birthday and who have not competed in classes in which the entry is required to jump higher than 3'. 6 to 8 Fences not to exceed 2'6"for medium and large ponies and horses and 2' for small ponies. One or more individual test of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USAE test 1-8). 10 points are required to required to qualify for this class. (10,6,4, and 2). Any qualifying Rider is not eligible to enter at future shows. A Mini Medal Rider who competes in the MHC Jr. Medal is no longer eligible to compete in the Mini Medal Division. To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course. Class 44.

MHJ MINI MEDAL

Open to riders who have not reached their 15th birthday as of December 1st of the current year and have not competed in any horsemanship class in which the rider is required to jump higher than 3' with the exception of the USE Federation Pony Medal. All contestants are to compete over a course not to exceed 8 fences and not less than 6 fences, at a height not to exceed 2'6". No combinations. Contestants are not allowed to cross enter into the National Children's Medal, WIHS ,MHC, NEHC and RIHA Medal, USEF Medal, USET or the ASPCA Horsemanship class at any show during the year. To fill a class at least 2 exhibitors must complete the course. Class 45.

SEHA MINI MEDAL

Open to SEHA Members who have not reached their 15th birthday as of December 1st of the current year and have not competed in any horsemanship class in which the rider is required to jump higher than 3' with the exception of the USE Federation Pony Medal. All contestants are to compete over a course not to exceed 8 fences and not less than 6 fences, at a height not to exceed 2'6". No combinations. Contestants are not allowed to cross enter into the National Children's Medal, WIHS ,MHC, NEHC and RIHA Medal, USEF Medal, USET or the ASPCA Horsemanship class at any show during the year. To fill a class at least 2 exhibitors must complete the course. Class 46.

Modified Adult Hunter (MHC Rated "C")

Open to Horses and Ponies ridden by Amateur Adult Riders eligible for the Modified Adult Equitation. Fences 2'3" to 2'6'. Riders may not cross enter into Amateur Adult Hunter Division. Classes 62, 63, 64

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER DIVISION (NEHC & MHC Rated "C")

To be ridden by amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. Horses may be shown by a different rider in any other division or class at the same competition. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, size of rider to mount, and suitability as an Adult Amateur Hunter. Horses and ponies may be jogged for soundness at Judge's discretion. Height of fences 3', spreads not to exceed height of fence. Ponies may be ridden by adults, suitability to count. Division may be divided if sufficient entries. Divisions may be divided if 6 entries in each section. 66, 67, 68

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY DIVISION (NEHC & MHC Rated "C")

To be shown by junior exhibitors. Height of fences-small/medium ponies 2'; large ponies 2'6" with spreads not to exceed fence heights. Ponies may not cross enter into the regular pony hunter division. Jogging for soundness at the discretion of the judge. Children's Hunter Horse and Children's Hunter Pony Division may be combined if less than 6 entries in each. Classes 70, 71, 72



MODIFIED ADULT EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to horses and ponies ridden by an amateur adult exhibitor. Riders may not cross enter into amateur adult equitation division. Fences not exceed 2'6. Classes 75, 76,77

BAY STATE ADULT MEDAL.

Open to Adult Amateur riders. All entries are required to perform over at least 8 jumps at 2'6". One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. Ten points are required to qualify for the finals. Class 78

MHJ MINI MEDAL.

Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 15th birthday as of December 1, with the exception of maiden and novice riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1. To perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 2'6". Competitors may cross enter into the MHJ Children's Medal Horse or Pony class at the Finals. To fill a class, at least two competitors must complete the course. Ten points are required to qualify for the Finals. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 1, 2017. After August 1, 2017 only those riders not qualified may compete in the Class. Class 79

Hunter Type Pet Pony

Open to riders under 14 years of age. To be judged on manners, performance and quality at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Classes 81, 82

Open Schooling Hunter Class

No restrictions to age or status of rider. Open all day at the respective height. Class 61

SCHOOLING JUMPER DIVISION

Open to all horses. Fence heights .70 M - .80M (as entries warrant) Classes 103, 104, 105 \$35 PER CLASS

HOPEFUL JUMPER DIVISION

Open to all horses and ponies. .80M-.85 jumps 2'6" to 2'9" Classes 100, 101, 102, \$35 PER CLASS

CHILDREN'S/ADULT JUMPER DIVISION

Open to exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1st of the current competition year and to amateur adult riders. Fences set 1.0 Meters. Cash winnings do not influence this classification. Horse/rider combinations showing in junior classes where fences are over 3'6" are not eligible for Children's/ Adult Jumpers. Section may be divided by age of rider or horse/pony if sufficient entries warrant. Champion and Reserve Champion. Champions will remain tied.
